WHAT DO CASA VOLUNTEERS DO?

CASA volunteers get to know the child and everyone involved in the child's life to advocate for the child's best interests while in the foster care system.

CASA VOLUNTEERS:

- Commit to at least one year of advocacy
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Participate in an in-depth training program
- Pass criminal and CPS background checks
- Are at least 21 years old
