SSBC focuses on putting an end to the generational involvement in the child welfare system through intensive services for parents with children 0-18 months old.

ANYONE CAN REFER A PARENT TO SAFE & SECURE BABY COURT:

Judges/Magistrates, community agencies, attorneys, DCYF, self-referrals, etc.

The SSBC Model relies on utilizing community-based services and/or Department of Health programs that can remain in place after the case closes to DCYF to ensure continued family success.

SSBC CORE COMPONENTS

- > A **SPECIALIZED COURT SOCIAL WORKER** is assigned to each family to provide additional support.
- > FREQUENT COURT APPEARANCES to monitor progress & identify barriers to reunification.
- > A MINIMUM OF THREE VISITS per week scheduled for parents and their children.
- This specialty court also offers a SPECIALZIED PARENT/CHILD ASSESSMENT through The Brown Center to identify strengths & needs for children and their parents.
- > BABY SUPPLIES provided as needed.
