## Leveraging AI

At East, we teach students to use AI responsibly — as a tool for thinking, not shortcutting.

Teachers use AI to work smarter, freeing time to build real relationships with students.

## **Will AI widen or close gaps?**

**AI can either close or widen gaps, depending on access and guidance.**

**Used well, it can personalize learning, support multilingual students, and improve accessibility.**

**We focus on digital literacy for all, ensuring every student can use AI effectively and safely.**

## AI & bullying

**AI can help flag concerning behavior early, but it's not a substitute for relationships.**

**We teach students that AI amplifies human behavior — respect and empathy must guide its use.**

**Prevention starts with culture and connection, not just technology.**



## Evolving teacher roles

**AI doesn't replace teachers; it frees them to do more of what matters — teaching and mentoring.**

**It can streamline lesson planning, grading, and data analysis.**

**Teachers need training not just in tools, but in ethics and balance — using AI without losing the human touch.**



## Integrate AI responsibly

**Clear guidelines and consistent messaging are key.**

**We teach digital citizenship: using AI to create, not copy; to connect, not isolate.**

**Technology should enhance relationships, never replace them.**



## Equity + privacy + responsible use

**Ensure equal access to technology and guided instruction for all students.**

**Be transparent about how tools and data are used.**
